

# WP/SCT/SCC Infection Control Policy Form For Contractors/Vendors

As a key employer in Washington County, ME, we have a need as a business to protect our employees/contractors/vendors by keeping them safe and that means mask wearing for unvaccinated Individuals

Since the COVID-19 outbreak began, our practice has been to follow the CDC guidelines and recommendations that have been issued during the COVID-19 outbreak.

In line with our approach to mitigating the risk to our workforce, beginning on Monday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, Individuals **who have been fully vaccinated** will no longer be required to wear COVID-19 approved face coverings while working at one of our mills in Baileyville, ME.

For Individuals who have **not yet been fully vaccinated**, they will still be required to wear a COVID-19 approved face coverings while working at one of our mills in Baileyville, ME, if they come within 6 feet of any employee or contractor working on site. This applies to both indoors and outdoors settings.
